Orphan Care Institutions:

Since the beginning of the epidemic, caregiving institutions of Al-Mabarrat Association have been devoted to provide care for orphans and those who suffer from social hardships, emphasizing comprehensive humanitarian care, by:

- ◆ Monitoring the educational process on the learning platform in order to overcome the obstacles of distance learning.
- ◆ Delivering CDs of lessons for children who do not have internet service at home.
- Providing several electronic devices, mobile phones, tablets, and DVDs to facilitate the learning process.





- Visiting children in different areas to follow up their daily life routines, social, health, and psychological conditions.
- ◆ Supporting orphans' families and destitute ones under the care of the Al-Mabarrat Association by providing financial aids, nutritious supplies, and heating devices. Preparing Iftar for orphans in the holy month of Ramadan.
- Distributing Eid clothes and gifts for 3900 orphans and indigent persons.
- Presenting the educational care program "Zadi towards a Good Life", which includes emotional social activities, learning activities, scientific activities and entertaining activities aiming at developing a whole rounded personality for every orphanage.

Educational Institutions:

Al-Mabarrat Association's academic and vocational schools have been extremely keen to implement appropriate adaptations in the teaching-learning process during the epidemic, and to turn the crisis into opportunities through:

- ◆ Ensuring the continuation of learning for more than %90 of the students (who reached over 20 thousands students). This number included 985 students with special needs in the inclusive classrooms, and 602 students who are deaf, blind, has language disorders, autism spectrum disorder, and intellectual disabilities.
- ◆ Launching an educational platform compatible with all electronic devices (Mobile phones, tablets and laptops).
- Preparing interactive educational material, and online remedial programs. In addition to conducting assessment forremote learning acquisitions..
- Uploading thousands of digital lessons (videos) and and tens of thousands of assignments, to ensure active interactions during virtual learning.













- Providing technological aid for parents and students by our Information Technology Team.
- Adopting programs to develop cognitive and social skills, and build students'self-esteem, in order to reach deep learning, and social and emotional learning skills.
- ◆ Cooperation with Siraj Center of Al- Mabarrat Association for Educational Diagnosis in order to provide direct therapeutic services for children with special needs and learning disabilities.
- ◆ Training blind and deaf students in Al Hadi institution to use the platform and read the contents of the courses.
- Sending digital lessons to the parents of children with special needs covering activities and techniques that target sensory, speech, psycho motor skills, cognitive skills, and daily life skills.
- ◆ Launching psycho-social service for students of Al-Mabarrat Schools.

Sponsoring the Graduates:

Al-Mabarrat proceeds to support high school graduates during their university studies, with the effort from Al-Mabarrat orphans` care institutions, Al-Mabarrat Alumni Association, and USAL University representing by:

- Providing financial aid to the lower tuition fees.
- Couching virtual vocational trainings meetings
- ◆ Launching "Tomooh" program at the University of Sciences and Arts in Lebanon (USAL). It is an academic scholarship program for indigent students through which 60 academic scholarships were granted for students in all facultie sreaching %100.

Health Initiatives:

Al-Mabarrat launched several health initiatives in the endeavor to support people. The most noteworthy ones were:

- ◆ Opening a special ward at Bahman Hospital to treat patients infected with Covid-19. This ward has a capacity of 50 beds, out of which 12 beds are in the ICU unit.
- ◆ Launching "Sa7tak Be-Aman" a health and social initiative at Dar Al-Aman Elderly Care Hospital. It aims at providing health services and aid to the elderly at their own homes. This initiative covered a number of villages in South Lebanon and Bekaa.
- Providing health care at outreach centers in different geographic areas.

'Albi 'A 'Albak Campaign:

Al-Mabarrat Association launched this campaign after the tragic Beirut Port explosion (4th of August 2020). It included the following:

- Setting up a field hospital at Bahman Hospital with the capacity for 400 wounded persons, and launching a blood donation campaign.
- ◆ Helping to remove the ruins caused by the explosion, in cooperation with Al-Mabarrat Scouts and Al-Mabarrat Graduates.
- ◆ Providing full sponsorship in Al-Mabarrat Institutions for 15 children of martyrs of the port explosion.
- Distributing thousands of rations to families in different affected areas.





- ◆ Providing psychological support by opening a center in Karentina.
- ◆ Distribution of clothes and other items which benefited more than 2000 families.

From people to people:

Al-Mabarrat Association instigated the following actions from within the charitable framework which emanated from the social, economic, and pandemic crises:

- Distributing thousands of rations and tangible aids to people in different areas of Lebanon without any sectarian or demographic discrimination.
- ◆ Al Aytam Petroleum launched an initiative to support taxi drivers and vans through providing diesel coupons for nearly 6000 drivers, and refilling about 30,000 gas containers for home uses, by means of donations from benefactors in Lebanon and abroad.
- ◆ Assaha Village and the Orphans' Care Institutions of Al-Mabarrat launched a project entitled "Souk Al Mouneh Al Baladiyeh". The purpose was to employ workers during lockdowns which were imposed due to the Covid19- crisis, sell the products of rural areas, and encourage village housewives to work.









The Association's Funds

The Association's funds are comprised of the following:

- ◆ Contributions from the Ministry of Social Affairs, the Ministry of Education and Higher Education, and international social organizations in Lebanon and abroad.
- ◆ The sponsorships from generous and considerate contributors to cover expenditures of the orphans, students with learning disabilities, and the elderly
- Khums, Zakat and Sadagah.
- ◆ Financial and donations provided by benefactors in Lebanon and abroad.
- ◆ Revenues from production enterprises that cover a part of the expenditure of Al-Mabarrat Institutions.
- Contributions from the members.



In addition, expenditures include, expenses for institutions maintenance, renovation of different departments and launching of new facilities.

- ◆ Three institutions for the deaf, blind, language impairment and communication disorders, including 602 of which are students with special needs.
- Threeeducational diagnostic centers.
- Five health and social centers and nursing homes for the elderly.
- Several Cultural and missionary centers, in addition to public libraries, religious institutes and mosques.
- Various investment projects to support the charity programs.
- Bahman University Hospital.
- University of Sciences and Arts in Lebanon USAL.
- ◆ Affiliations: Al-Mabarrat Alumni Association, Al-Mabarrat Scouts, Union of Al-Mabarrat Friends, Al-Mabarrat Women's Organization, Al-Mabarrat Sports Club, and Al-Mabarrat Sports Academy.
