- Lebanon has been facing an unprecedented set of crises since 2020. 

These harsh conditions have victimized the children who have, as results of that, become highly vulnerable to school or university drop-out.
- Adhering to its mission and being assiduous to provide the needed support for its community and people during these crises, Al-Mabarrat determinedly continued providing the educational duty and service in its schools and university maintaining the same quality that has been given and applied ever since it was established, 45 years ago.
- Being committed to subsidizing the salaries of the employees and teachers, as a crucial act of appreciation and support, to be able to live and afford getting life necessities after the crash of the values of the Lebanese currency.
- According to this bitter reality, Al-Mabarrat innately found itself driven to respond. As it has always done, and be by the side of its people, giving the various kinds of support. To be able to do so, Al-Mabarrat has always depended and appealed to the philanthropists, who are remarkable supportive, collaborative, and magnanimous, and whose role in that process is highly important.
- Recently, Al-Mabarrat is launching an initiative that aims at providing financial aids for students, particularly those who have withdrawn and might withdraw from schools due to the economic hardship, addition to lifting the financial burden off the parents' shoulders.
